

## Procrastinating Quilters Meeting Minutes

June 15, 2017

A executive meeting was called at 6:45 PM. Those present were Barbara Saydeh, Pauline Mallory, Karen Pieczonka, Linda, Miriam Scott, and SueAnn Suderman. The Opportunity Quilt for the 2019 quilt show was discussed. Decided on the pattern; Aviatrix Medallion by Elizabeth Hartman. It was also reported that to become a 503(c) 3 organization would cost \$275.00.

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Pauline Mallory, president.

Karen Pieczonka and Pam Sprague introduced a proposal to attend the Jacksonville Quilt Show on September 23, 2017 as a group. It is a large show with 70+ vendors. Cost per person would be about \$60.00 per person for the bus if enough people wanted to participate. Tickets for the show are \$10.00. More details to come as they become available.

The guest speaker, fiber artist Karen Stockwell, presented an informative program about Round Robin quilts. Her show and tell of the Round Robin quilts she had with her was amazing. She was on the cover of American Quilters Magazine in October 2016.

Pauline Mallory gave a report about her trip to the Minnesota Quilt Show.

Pauline Mallory led a discussion about PQ applying for 201(3)c, tax exempt status. PQ is already registered with the State of Florida, is incorporated, and has a tax ID number. PQ had started the process once before but stopped because of lack of funds for the fee which is \$275.00. Funds are not an issue at this time. Carol Hemmingsen made a motion to pursue 503(c)3 status. The motion was seconded and passed.

Pauline Mallory reported on the Opportunity Quilt for the 2019 Quilt Show. The pattern, Aviatrix Medallion by Elizabeth Hartman, was passed around for members to look at. A committee will be formed to make the quilt.

Carol Hemmingsen reported on the 2019 quilt show. The quilt show theme is "A Quilters Journey". The organizing group is looking for a few more committee

heads. Two committees have been added; Advertising and Volunteer Coordinator. The Boutique chair is Laura Resnic from Largo Cracker Quilters.

Membership Chair, Teri Roberts, reported that PQ now has 60 paid members.

Sunshine chair, Paula Riccio, reported that she had sent a card to Stephanie Sheppa.

Karen Barrie reported that the Mystery Quilt event was a success. There was a good turnout and the church it was held at was a nice venue and had lots of plugs. The quilt was cute also.

Janice Magee reported that the newsletter looks great.

Report on the 2018 Retreat. 40 people have already signed up. PQ has a contract and payments will be made in stages. The previously reported cost of the retreat will change if the tax exempt status is approved.

Barbara Saydah won the 50/50 drawing.

Patty Merry reported that the PQ website is now under the name procrastinatingquilters.com.

Show and tell was shared.
